## Politically Correct is an Oxymoron

Why is the **Hegelian Dialectic** important? Because it influenced **Karl Marx**, who bequeathed to the earth, the most horrible political world view ever conceived in modern times.

Chronicler [Rebecca Cooper](#) <sup>(1, 2)</sup> lists three intellectual influences on Marx, including, but notably: "... that modification of the philosophy of Hegel himself, represented by the Left Movement of the Young Hegelians, in which connection the name of [Feuerbach](#) is outstanding."

Marx's use of Hegel's dialectic would be aimed at economics—with his materialist dialect he (and Engels) gave us [communism](#). In the West at least, Communism, or **Economic Marxism**, essentially collapsed with the fall of the Soviet Union. But it did not die. Communism survives today in a much more insidious, and invasive form called **Political Correctness**, best described as **cultural Marxism**. It has been so successfully practiced in America for the last 80 years, that it is difficult to think current generations will ever be able to overcome its sickening influence.

The connection from Hegel to Marx, to PC (cultural Marxism) ultimately explains every insanity on full display in our nation today. The process has been deliberate, methodical, camouflaged, relentless, and horribly, horribly effective. Ironically, those who have **not** been beguiled by cultural Marxism are the only people with “common sense.” Sadly, common sense is simply not so common today. In an ideological war, common sense, though valuable, is not enough... what’s needed is wisdom.

***Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field that the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat of any tree in the garden?'"*** (Genesis 3:1)

[This passage could be viewed as the first example of the dialectic at work. Question truth, then simply wait for the mind and human pride to do the rest.]

The trail of “intellectuals” who advanced cultural Marxism include some pretty unhappy campers. Many immigrated to, or were born in **America**: George Lukaks, Antonio Gramsci, William Reich, Erich Fromm, Herbert Marcuse, Theodor Adorno, and [Benjamin Bloom](#) <sup>(3)</sup> to name just a few. Without exception, they desired to fundamentally transform, even destroy Western civilization. America's

Christian heritage and traditions were especially held in contempt.

### **There are five parallels with cultural Marxism and economic Marxism:** <sup>(4)</sup>

**1. A “classless society”** They are not at all interested in equal opportunity, but rather a society of equal condition, or equal outcome. This contradicts the God-given human nature: while everyone is “created equal,” everyone is different. Society will not accord with equal condition unless coerced, which is why cultural Marxism invariably is totalitarian.

**2. The notion of a single-factor view of history** Economic Marxism, determined history by the ownership of material production. Today, history is explained by group identities—particularly those groups that have power over other groups: through race, sex, and sexual normality/abnormality.

**3. Certain groups are virtuous, and others are evil a priori.** The trope “black lives matter” is both polarizing and indisputable. All we are left to think is that white people—especially white men—are evil. Likewise, so are heterosexuals, and non-feminist women.

**4. Appropriation.** Cultural Marxists, when they gain power, will tax the rich, (see first parallel) while penalizing private ownership, then give to the groups they

favor. Affirmative action is a perfect example of this.

**5. Deceitful ideological analysis.** The favorite tools all Marxists employ is the **deconstruction of language**. Language they claim oppresses women, blacks, or homosexuals is deemed **offensive** through the use of *phony* analyses. They aim to separate, humiliate, and demoralize dissenters.

**But there is good news... There is always Good News!**

There is one force on earth that cultural Marxism cannot ultimately overcome: **The Church**. Even though the [local churches](#), are struggling right now to stand and face this enemy, cultural Marxism, like the gates of hell, will not prevail against **The Body of Christ**. The elitist intellectuals are no match for the wisdom God gives us. **Simply resist them**, and see how weak these anarchists really are.
